ACTION TAKEN REPORT AGAINST STUDENTS' FEEDBACK-2021-22

1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?

Interpretation of the Feedback:

It was inferred from the feedback that only $69+28+9 = 106$ students (i.e. 15%) of the students said that the syllabus was covered below 70%.

Action Taken by the college: It was found that during the lockdown period, as the classes were held online, principally through Google Meet or WhatsApp Video Calls, there was a network issue. Students principally residing at interior villages had poor network connectivity, and were the worst affected. They mostly could not login and in many cases it was found that continuous streaming was not available. Hence they could not access the lectures of the Teacher, which led to the diverging distribution of opinion among the students. Since the college cannot do anything about the internet connectivity, the college could not take any step to rectify this problem.
