






**Report on Add-on Course titled "Introduction to New Literature" conducted

## Report on Add-on Course titled 'Applications of Graph Theory: Networking'


The Department of Mathematics took initiative to introduce the first Add-on course on continuous encouragement from the Principal. In the departmental meeting dated 14.12.2021, it was decided to start the first add-on course during the semester January, 2022 to June, 2022 and the target was approximately 100 students were from Mathematics (Hons.), Physics (Hons.), Computer Science (Hons.) and Chemistry (Hons.); though 85 students enrolled from the stated departments. It was decided that frequency of classes would be two hours per week and probably on Friday & Saturday before and after the scheduled routine.

The objective of the course to demonstrate how the networking is done from a Mathematical perspective, to present examples of large-scale networks that we rely on every day e.g. transportation networks, social networks, etc. and to develop uses of graph-theoretical techniques in modeling and routing in networking.


