PREAMBLE

Whereas Sustainable Development Goal Bridge India and National Service Units Scheme (NSS) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA, PI) of Nistarini College, Purulia, West Bengal have many areas of common interest in the science, Technology, Science Education, Research, Rural and Tribal Development, Livelihood, Rural Development, Conservation, Awareness and Capacity Building considerable advantages may be gained from their pursuit on a collaborative basis in the field of academics, education, and research NOW THEREFORE, Sustainable Development Goal Bridge India and National Service Units Scheme (NSS) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA, PI) of Nistarini College, Purulia, have decided to enter this memorandum of understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two-institution set out in the following section.

OBJECTIVES

Both institutes agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academics areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity.

- The two institutions shall seek to promote Education Officer/Scientist/staff Exchange
- The exchange of Officers to the mutual benefit of both institution Collaboration in teaching, research, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest.
- The exchange of academic material and publication Conduct lectures Undertaking joint research
- Attachment of staff for purpose of curriculum development and review, attendance of course, upgrading of teaching and research skills,
- Participating and organizing seminars, symposium, conferences, and other type of academic discussion
- Conducting student tour and joint consultancy work
 - Open an Environment and climate action and Science club
- Capacity building of student and ensure their participation in different environment

conservation , Rural and Tribal Development, natural resource conservation and livelihood activities.

COORDINATION

Each institution shall appoint one member of its teaching/ research faculty to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further, a coordination committee consisting of a programme coordinator from the side of Sustainable Development Goal Bridge India and a programme coordinator from the side of, National Service Units Scheme (NSS) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan(UBA,PI) of Nistarini College,Purulia ,will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions. Page | 2

Ownership of any intellectual property (Including but not limited to confidential information, know- how, patents, copyrights, design right, rights related to computer software, and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both institutes to this memorandum.

OTHER AREA

- To exchange information on research and educational programs.
- To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programs,
- To jointly organize short-term continuing education programs on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's expertise to participate therein
- To organize jointly seminar, conference, or workshop on the topic of mutual interest and to invite each other faculty to participate therein
- To propose and exchange jointly in research or training programs sponsored by the funding agencies and to invite each other Expertsto participate therein
- To exchange on a reciprocal basis, students at undergraduate, graduate, and youths for limited periods of time for the purpose of Project formulation and research
- To use laboratory facilities in specific cases for a limited period.

Validity

The memorandum shall remain in force for a period of Five years commencing form effectives date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review. Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of three months in advance to the other institution. Once terminated, neither Sustainable Development Goal Bridge India and National Service Units Scheme (NSS) Unnat Bharat Abhiyan(UBA,PI) of Nistarini College,Purulia ,will be responsible for



Department of Environmental Science, Unnat Bharat Abhiyan and National Service Scheme, Nistarini College, Purulia, West-Bengal (hereinafter NCP) and Department of Sociology, Govt. College Chamba, Himachal Pradesh, India, (hereinafter GCC) recognizing the benefits to their respective college/department from the establishment of collaborative links, conclude this Memorandum of Understanding MoU as follows:

1. The purpose of this MoU is to develop academic and educational cooperation and to promote mutual understanding between the two Parties.
2. Each Party agrees to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on a basis of equality and reciprocity:
 - 2.1) Exchange of academic and administrative staff
 - 2.2) Exchange of students
 - 2.3) Conducting collaborative research projects
 - 2.4) Conducting lectures and organizing symposia (On-line and off line)
 - 2.5) Exchange of academic information and materials
 - 2.6) Promoting collaboration in fields of mutual interest
 - 2.7) Promoting other academic cooperation as mutually agreed
3. The development and implementation of specific activities based on this MoU will be separately negotiated and agreed between the college and departments including UBA and NSS activities which carry out the specific projects and will be subject to a separate written agreement. Each Party agrees to carry out these activities in accordance with the laws and regulations of the respective countries/state after full consultation and approval.
4. It is understood that the implementation of any of the types of co-operation stated in Clause 2 shall depend upon the availability of resources and financial support of the Parties concerned.



5. Both Parties agree that prior written approval is required before using the other Party's name, logo, or other Intellectual Property rights in any advertising or associated publicity.
6. Should the collaborative research activities under this MoU result in any potential for intellectual property, each Party shall seek an equitable and fair agreement as to ownership and other property interests that may arise.
7. This MoU may only be amended or modified by a written agreement signed by the representatives of each Party.
8. This MoU is valid for a period of five years from the date of signing by the authorized signatories of each Party. Each Party shall review the status of the MoU at least three months before the end of the five-year period to determine whether it wishes the MoU to continue and, if so, any modifications that might be necessary. The period of validity of this MoU may only be extended by the mutual written consent of both Parties.
9. This MoU may, at any time during its period of validity, be terminated by one of the Parties upon prior notice to the other in writing not later than six months before the termination date.
10. The Parties may disclose certain confidential information to the other in relation to any future proposal made under this MoU. Each Party therefore agrees that the contents of this MoU and the negotiations in relation to any future proposal remain strictly confidential and each Party hereby undertakes not to disclose the same to any third Party, save for its professional advisers, without the prior written consent of the other Party except where such disclosure is required by law (including, without limitation, under applicable freedom of information legislation).

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is effective as of 17/4/2021 (Effective date) to establish an affiliation by and between

Maheshtala College, an undergraduate degree college with its office at Budge Budge Trunk Road, P.O.Chandannagar, Kolkata-141, P.S.Maheshtala, District South 24 – Parganas, established in 1971, hereinafter referred to as MC and represented by its Principal, referred to as FIRST PART,

AND

Nistarini college, Purulia, one of the premiere academic institute in the State of West Bengal (University of Sidho-Kanho-Birsha) established in the year 1957. It is located in Deshbandhu Road, Purulia - 723101, West Bengal. This College, hereinafter referred to as NC and represented by its Principal, referred to as SECOND PART, for the the of exchange of students, staff and faculty.

The aforesaid institutions are hereinafter referred to individually/collectively as college/colleges.

PREAMBLE

Whereas, MC and NC have many areas of common interest in Arts subject, considerable advantage may be gained from their pursuit of academic excellence on a collaborative basis in the fields of academics, pedagogy and research.

Now therefore, MC and NC have decided to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as MoU), which defines the framework for the cooperation of the two institutions in the following sections.

ARTICLE 1: OBJECT

Both colleges agree to develop the following collaborative activities in the academic areas of mutual interest, on the basis of equality and reciprocity.

The two institutions shall seek to promote:

A. Faculty/Staff exchanges

- i) Faculty exchange for the mutual benefit of both the institutions
- ii) Collaboration in teaching, research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest
- iii) Exchange of academic materials and publications
- iv) Conducting lectures
- v) Undertaking joint research
- vi) Participating in seminars, workshops, symposia, other kinds of academic discussions,
- vii) Conducting study tours and joint consultancy work

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity and detailed arrangements for such collaborative work will be agreed upon. Terms and conditions for each visit will be worked out, keeping financial costs involved to the minimum.

B. Student Exchange

- a) Students in the exchange programme will be selected by mutual agreement between the home and the host college.
 - b) Exchange students may be evaluated by the host institution if such an evaluative framework for the academic interest of students be worked out; this will in no way impede or influence her/his evaluation in home college or university assessment/evaluation.
- C. Other areas
- a) To exchange information on research and educational programmes
 - b) To exchange information on teaching, learning material and other literature relevant to their educational and research programmes
 - c) To jointly organise seminars, faculty development programmes, workshops on topics of mutual interest and to invite each other's faculty to participate therein
 - d) To explore the provision of cultural and intellectual enrichment opportunities for staff, faculty and students of both institutes.
 - e) To use library reading room facilities for a specified period
 - f) To use laboratory facilities in specific cases (with prior approval of Principal) for a limited period.

MC and NC agree that detailed terms and conditions that guide each activity identified above will be determined separately and agreed upon by the two colleges. These terms will include a technical description of the proposed activity, financial arrangements, and person(s) responsible for its implementation.

ARTICLE 2 : COORDINATION

Each college shall appoint one member of its teaching faculty to coordinate the programme on behalf of the Principal of each college. Further, a Coordination Committee consisting of two Principals and the two Coordinators will periodically (once or twice a year) review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between two colleges.

ARTICLE 3: CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

The two colleges will retain and respect individual confidentiality, including those pertaining to the collaborative activities of both colleges.

ARTICLE 4 : INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

Ownership of any intellectual property (including but not limited to confidential information, know-how, patents, copyrights, design rights, rights relating to computer software and any other industrial or intellectual property rights) developed jointly during the course of this MoU shall be vested in both the colleges in this MoU. Both the colleges shall have right to determine the commercial implications, disposition and exploitation of such intellectual property and shall make joint applications for the registration of the same. Any publication regarding such intellectual property shall be possible with prior written consent of both colleges.

ARTICLE 5 : VALIDITY

The MoU shall remain in force for a period of FIVE years commencing from the effective date. Institutions may extend the term by written agreement signed by both after review.

ARTICLE 6: TERMINATION

Either institution may terminate the MoU by giving written notice of six months in advance to the other institution.

ARTICLE 7: LEGAL EFFECT

Nothing in this MoU shall be construed as creating any legal relationship between the two colleges. This Memorandum is a statement of intent to foster genuine and mutually beneficial collaboration.

ARTICLE 8: DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case of a dispute relating to any aspect of academic cooperation, Principals of both colleges will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility.

Maheshtala College and Nistarini College welcome the establishment of this Memorandum for cooperation and jointly agree to the provisions set out as above.
