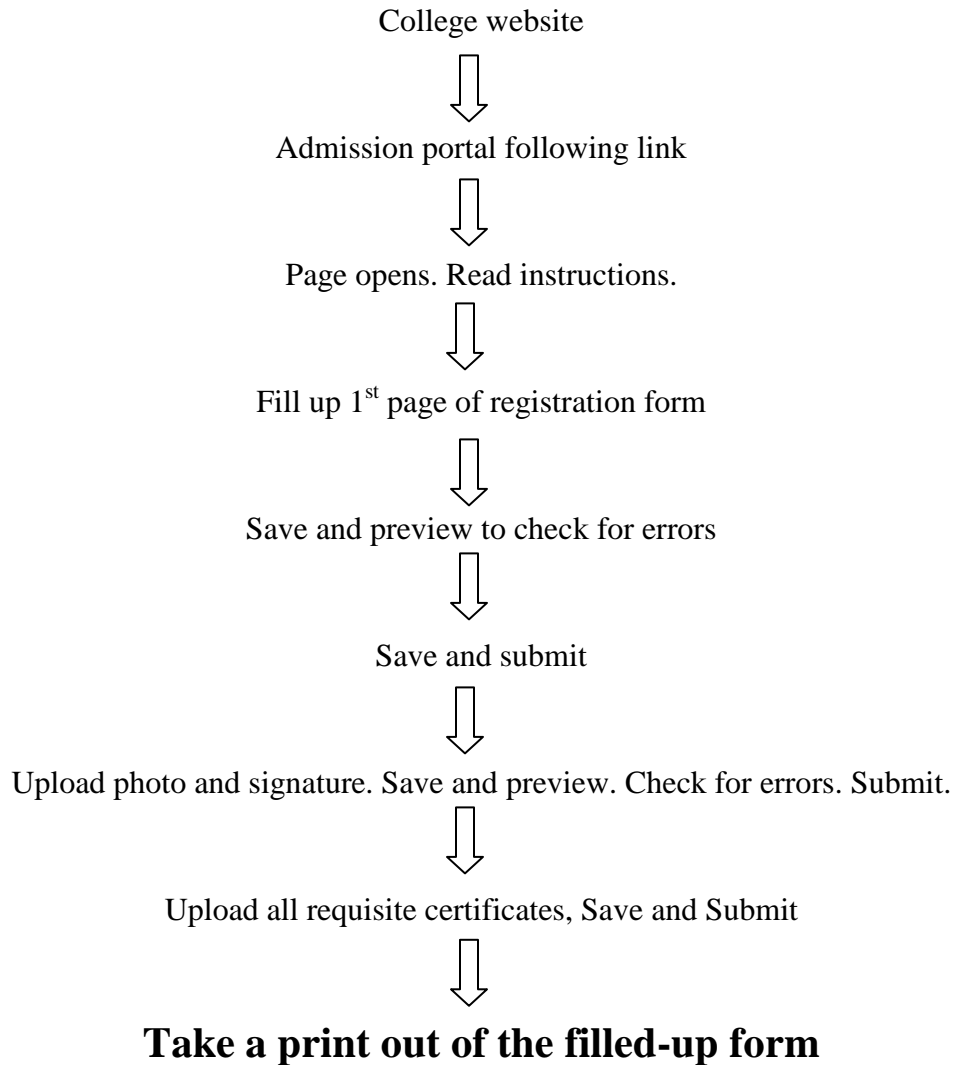
**in**

**4 years-UG Course with Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research)**

- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary examination or its equivalent (10+ 2) are eligible to apply for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> year/ 1<sup>st</sup> semester UG Courses. The student must have studied a minimum of 5 subjects of 100 marks each at the H.S. level.
- From this year (2023) the admission in UG courses will be in the system **Curriculum & Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP)** in accordance with NEP, 2020; all the students will be admitted in UG Course with **one Major Subject**. A student has to admit in 4 years UG-Course with Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research) with multiple entry and exit options;
  - ✓ after **successful completion of One year of study** (completion of 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Semester) if a student wishes to exit from the course she will be awarded **Certificate in Major Subject**,
  - ✓ after **successful completion of Two years of study** (completion of 4 semesters) if a student wishes to exit from the course she will be awarded **Diploma in Major Subject**,
  - ✓ after **successful completion of Three years of study** (completion of 6 Semesters) if a student wishes to exit from the course she will be awarded **UG Degree in Major Subject**
  - ✓ and after **successful completion of Four years of study** (Completion of 8 Semesters) the student will be awarded **UG Degree in Major Subject (with Hons. or Hons. with Research)**.
  - ✓ There will be option for re-entry into the course for those students who exit the course after successful completion of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> year of study; on getting the permission from the College and the University
- Students may choose the following subjects as **Major**  
**Bengali, Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Education, English, Environmental Science, Geography, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Music, Nutrition, Philosophy, Physics, Physical Education, Political Science, Sanskrit and Zoology**

## Online Application procedure:

- The total process for admission to 1<sup>st</sup> year classes is online, through the college website [www.nistarinicollege.ac.in](http://www.nistarinicollege.ac.in). The following methodology must be followed –



## **ADMISSION PROCEDURE & NORMS**

**(To be read carefully by candidate before filling up form)**

- Admission will be done strictly on the basis of the merit lists published online.
- Admission procedure will be conducted through online process only.
- Students who have passed HS or equivalent (10+2) examination in 2023, 2022, and 2021 are eligible for admission into the 1<sup>st</sup> year / 1<sup>st</sup> Semester class.
- All the applicant students should give their own Mobile Number and e-mail address during fill-up of online application form; these are very essential during the entire admission process and during course tenure.
- **The applicants will fill up for UG Courses by choosing one subject as Major. The maximum number of choice for choosing Major subject to any applicant will be Three.**
- The students will have to wait for the merit lists, which will be published on pre-notified dates. Students will choose their subjects as given in the admission form.
- **If the name of a student published in one of the merit list with Major subject as one of her three choices then the choice of Major may be upgraded maximum two times more, as long as online admission process continues and seats remain vacant in that subject(s).**
- All students will have to choose **two Minor Subjects from two Groups of subjects**. Both will be allotted as per availability of seats.
- **After the commencement of classes and closing of online admission procedure, whichever be later, there will be no change from one Major subject to another Major.**
- All admission fees will be paid online, and students will come to the college only at the commencement of classes, which will be notified online.
- Reservation quotas as per government rules will be maintained for SC, ST, OBC A, OBC B, EWS (certificate to be issued in the current financial year) and PWD candidates. Original copies of all certificates will have to be produced at the time of verification in the college.
- Students who wish to opt for Environmental Science, Nutrition, and Computer Science as Major subject, must have Science background in the 10+2 level of study.

- **The merit panel will be prepared on the basis of total marks of best four subjects of H.S. plus the marks of the subject chosen as Major.**
  - ✓ **In the case of choice of ‘Environment Science’ and ‘Nutrition’ as Major subject the marks of Chemistry will be added with the total of best four subjects for merit panel.**
  - ✓ **In the case of choice of ‘Computer Science’ as Major subject the marks of Mathematics will be added with the total of best four subjects for merit panel.**
  - ✓ **In the case of choice of ‘Education’, ‘Economics’, ‘Music’ and ‘Physical Education’ as Major subject the total of best four subjects marks will be considered for merit panel.**

**Note: Marks of Compulsory Environmental Studies / Environmental Education will not be taken in any calculation.**

- Any false information whatsoever will lead to the immediate cancellation of candidature, even if the student has been admitted with full fees. No fees will be refunded in that case.
- 1<sup>st</sup> Year Candidates who failed to fill up examination forms for Sem-1 and Sem-2 Exams. in 2022-23, will have to apply afresh for admission to the 1<sup>st</sup> Year class of 2023.
- Only candidates who have passed the H.S. or equivalent (10+2) exams in 2023, 2022 and 2021 will be eligible to apply for admission into the 1<sup>st</sup> Year/ 1<sup>st</sup> Semester UG Course.
- Only candidates who have obtained HS or equivalent degree from a recognized institution will be eligible to apply for admission into 1<sup>st</sup> semester, UG Courses.

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Passed H.S. or Equivalent (10+2) Examinations with 45% Marks in aggregate (As per Mark sheet, except considering the marks of compulsory Environmental Education or Environment Studies).
- Applicant students may apply the subjects as Major if they studied those subjects in H.S. or Equivalent (10+2) Examinations, except Education, Economics, Music, Physical Education, Environment Science and Nutrition, these subjects may or may not be subject of study in H.S. or Equivalent (10+2) Examinations.

### **Verification of testimonials:**

- After online admission is over, verification of testimonials will be done on the date the college opens for classes of Semester I.
- There will be verification of all **original** testimonials, including caste certificates.
- Candidates will have to come physically with all documents.
- The following documents will have to be produced at the time of verification :
  - a. HS or equivalent Mark sheet and Certificate.
  - b. MP or equivalent Mark sheet and Certificate.
  - c. Certificate or admit card of M.P. or equivalent examination.
  - d. SC / ST / OBC A / OBC B / EWS (to be issued in current financial year) / PWD (Person with disability) certificate.
  - e. School-leaving certificate.
  - f. A set of attested copies of all the above documents.
  - g. One copy of Passport-size coloured photo.
- **Any false information provided during online counseling will lead to immediate cancellation of admission, and no refund of any fees will be permitted.**

### **CCFUP (Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes) through semesters:**

The UG Course is now four-year degree course, divided into eight semesters. Examinations will be held after each semester and semester-wise mark sheets with grade points (SGPA) will be issued by the university. The total grade points (CGPA) will be given, along with marks, in the final mark sheet. Students have to opt for 4 years UG Course with a subject as Major.

### **4 years - UG course with Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research)**

A student admitted into 4 years UG-course with Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research) in Arts / Science will have to study the following papers over eight semesters. All papers carry 50 marks each.

- 1) Core Course (CC) in Major subject (with Hons.) – 18 Papers  
or Core Course (CC) in Major subject (Hons. with Research)-16 Papers & 2 Papers on Research Project
- 2) Two Minor Subjects – 4 Papers each
- 3) Multi-disciplinary Course (MDC) – Three Courses with 1 Paper each
- 4) Ability Enhancement Compulsory course (AEC) – 2 papers (One in Communicative English and One in MIL).
- 5) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) – Three Courses with 1 Paper each
- 6) Value Added Course (VAC) – Two Courses with 1 Paper each

## **The semester-wise break-up is as follows –**

- 1) **Semester I: Major** (Paper 1), **Minor-I** (Paper-1), **MDC** (Subject -I), **SEC** (Subject-I), **VAC** (Subject-I)
- 2) **Semester II: Major** (Paper 2), **Minor-II** (Paper-1), **MDC** (Subject-II), **SEC** (Subject-II), **AEC** (Communicative English), **Summer Internship**
- 3) **Semester III: Major** (Paper 3), **Minor-I** (Paper-2), **MDC** (Subject-III), **SEC** (Subject-III), **VAC** (Subject-II)
- 4) **Semester IV: Major** (Paper 4 & 5), **Minor-II** (Paper-2), **AEC** (MIL), **Summer Internship**
- 5) **Semester V: Major** (Paper 6 & 7), **Minor-I** (Paper-3), **Minor-II** (Paper-3),
- 6) **Semester VI: Major** (Paper 8, 9 & 10 and one **Outreach / Internship**)
- 7) **Semester VII: Major** (Paper 11, 12 & 13), **Minor-I** (Paper-4), **Minor-II** (Paper-4),
- 8) **Semester VIII: Major** (Paper 14, 15 & 16) and  
**Major** (Paper-17 & 18) for **Major (Hons.)**  
or **Major** (2 Papers of Research Project/ Dissertation) for **Major (Hons. with Research)**

## **Subject options for Minor Subjects:**

**Group I** (One subject different from the Major Subject studied in Semester I, IV, V & VII to be chosen from this group) – **Bengali, Botany, Chemistry, Education, English, Environmental Science, Music, Physics, Philosophy, Sanskrit.**

**Group II** (One subject different from the Major Subject studied in Semester II, III, V & VII to be chosen from this group) – **Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Geography, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Nutrition, Physics, Physical Education & Sports, Political Science, Zoology.**

- d) Admission from 1<sup>st</sup> merit list- **21<sup>st</sup> July, 2023 (from 6.00 a.m.) to 23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2023 (upto 6.00 p.m.)**
- e) Publication of 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list – **23<sup>rd</sup> July, 2023, after 6.00 p.m.**
- f) Admission from 2<sup>nd</sup> merit list -**24<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 (from 6.00 a.m.) to 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2023 (upto 6.00 p.m.)**

At the time of Admission or Examination, University Fees to be paid as per university directives and norms.

### **LIBRARY CAUTION MONEY:**

Library caution money of Rs. 150.00 to be paid for admitted students at the time of admission, 75% of this amount will be refunded within 3 months from the date of publication of the final year result, on prayer.
