### Report for: QIm. 2.5.1

As per the guidelines and instructions of the Examination Committee of Nistarini College, along with the University (SKBU) guideline the Department of Bengali conducts its final Internal Assessment program (for 10 marks.) in proper way. As per our normal practice, written examinations are conducted for both U.G. and P.G. courses for Honours and GE Course curriculum, while for the Program Course the department used to conduct oral interview based test as their internal assessment. Only during the COVID period (2020-21, 21-22), all exams were conducted through online mode. So far, no complaints and grievances were lodged by our students regarding the fairness and transparency of these assessment processes.

But only in some cases while some students were not allowed to participate in these exams processes due to shortage of their required no. of class attendances (75%), some petitions were submitted by those defaulter students, stating the reasons behind their absences in classes. In those cases, those students, along with their guardians were called for being attend before the Departmental Committee to explain with sufficient evidences in favor of their absences and thereafter actions were taken to solve these problems as per the advice and suggestions of the respected Principal of the college.

Apart from these departmental issues, students sometimes lodge their complaints on different college related issues, such as inadequacy of drinking water, washroom, subject related books in college library, tutorial classes, incomplete syllabus, etc. In such cases, our departmental committee drew attention of the college authority on those issues and tried to solve these problems as far as possible.
