- Students who have passed the Higher Secondary examination or its equivalent (10+2) in the years 2026, 2025, 2024, 2023, 2022 are eligible to apply for admission to the 1st year/ 1st semester UG Courses. The student must have taken a minimum of 5 subjects of 100 marks each at the H.S. (10+2) level.
- From the year 2023 the admission in UG courses is in the system **Curriculum & Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programme (CCFUP)** in accordance with **NEP, 2020**; all the students will be admitted in UG Course with **one Major Subject**. A student has to admit in 4 years UG-Course with **Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research)** with **multiple entry and exit** options;
 - ✓ after **successful completion of One year of study** (completion of 1st and 2nd Semester) if a student wish to exit from the course she will be awarded **Certificate in Major Subject**,
 - ✓ after **successful completion of Two years of study** (completion of 4 semesters) if a student wish to exit from the course she will be awarded **Diploma in Major Subject**,
 - ✓ after **successful completion of Three years of study** (completion of 6 Semesters) if a student wish to exit from the course she will be awarded **UG Degree in Major Subject**,
 - ✓ and after **successful completion of Four years of study** (Completion of 8 Semesters) the student will be awarded **UG Degree in Major Subject (with Hons. or Hons. with Research)**.
 - ✓ There will be an option for re-entry into the course for those students who exit the course after successful completion of 1st, 2nd or 3rd year of study; on getting permission from the College and the University.
- Students may choose the following subjects as **Major** in Nistarini College, Purulia
Bengali, Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Economics, Education, English, Environmental Science, Geography, Hindi, History, Mathematics, Music, Nutrition, Philosophy, Physics, Physical Education, Political Science, Sanskrit and Zoology.

- **CCFUP (Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programme) through semesters:**

The UG Course is now four-year degree course, divided into **eight semesters**. Examinations will be held after each semester and semester-wise mark sheets with grade points (SGPA) will be issued by the university. The total grade points (CGPA) will be given, along with marks, in the final mark sheet. Students have to opt for 4 years UG Course with a subject as Major.

4 years - UG course with Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research)

A student admitted into 4 years UG-course with Major (Hons. / Hons. with Research) in Arts / Science will have to study the following papers over eight semesters.

- 1) Core Course (CC) in Major subject (with Hons.) – **18 Papers**
or Core Course (CC) in Major subject (Hons. with Research) - **16 Papers & 2 Equivalent Papers on Research Project/ Dissertation**
- 2) Two Minor Subjects – **4 Papers each**
- 3) Multi-disciplinary Course (MDC) – **Three Courses with 1 Paper each**
- 4) Ability Enhancement Compulsory course (AEC) – **2 papers** (1 in Communicative English and 1 in Modern Indian Language (MIL) (Bengali/ Hindi).
- 5) Skill Enhancement Course (SEC) – **Three Courses with 1 Paper each**
- 6) Value Added Course (VAC) – **Two Courses with 1 Paper each**

- 6) **Semester VI:** Major (Paper 8, 9 & 10 and one **Outreach / Internship Prog.**)
- 7) **Semester VII:** Major (Paper 11, 12 & 13), **Minor-I** (Paper-4), **Minor-II** (Paper-4),
- 8) **Semester VIII:** Major (Paper 14, 15 & 16) and Major (Paper-17 & 18) for **Major (Hons.)**
or **Major** (Research Project/ Dissertation) for **Major (Hons. with Research)**

ADMISSION PROCEDURE & NORMS

- **From the year 2024, the admission of the UG Courses in the Govt./Govt. Sponsored/Govt. Aided Colleges across all the Affiliating Universities and Districts in the State of West Bengal is processing through the Centralised Admission Portal (CAP) a single window, monitored and governed by the West Bengal State Council of Higher Education, Govt. of West Bengal.**
- All the applicants will be applied through the centralised admission portal <https://wbcap.in>, the applicants may also enter into this portal from the website of West Bengal State Council of Higher Education (<https://wbsche.wb.gov.in>) or Banglar Uchchashiksha-West Bengal (<https://banglaruchchashiksha.wb.gov.in>) or by clicking in the link <https://wbcap.in> Through this **Centralised Admission Portal (CAP)** students may take admission in the subjects **Bengali, Economics, Education, English, Geography, Hindi, History, Philosophy, Physical Education & Sports, Political Science, Sanskrit, Botany, Chemistry, Computer Science, Environmental Science, Mathematics, Nutrition, Physics and Zoology.**
- **To Take Admission in Music Major**, the students have to apply in the **College Website through the link https://admissionistarinicollege.in/student_login.aspx**
The admission in **Music Major** will be done through the college website in the standalone mode apart from all other Major Courses through the Centralised Admission Portal vide Govt. Order 265-Edn (CS)/ OM-102L/2022 dt. 24.04.2023.
- **Application Window in the Centralised Admission Portal will remain open according to the publication of the requisite Order from the Higher Education Department, Govt. of W.B. Similarly, application Window in the College Admission Portal for Music Major will also remain open.**
- Admission will be done strictly on the basis of the merit lists published in the Centralised Admission Portal and admission fees to be paid online for all subjects except Music Major.
- For admission in Music Major, admission will also be done strictly on the basis of the merit lists published in the College Admission Portal and admission fees to be paid online.
- **All the applicant students should give their own Mobile Number and e-mail address during registration for application of admission; these are very essential and mandatory during the entire admission process.**

- **The applicants will fill up for UG Courses by choosing one subject as Major. The maximum number of choices for choosing Major subject to any applicant will be Twenty Five across all colleges in the state of West Bengal in the centralised admission portal.**
- **Every step of the admission process will be intimated from the Centralised Admission Portal to the registered students through SMS & e-mail in the registered mobile number and e- mail address; students should be very careful and attentive to their mobile and e-mail every time for checking information send from the Centralised Admission Portal.**
- **If the name of a student published in one of the merit list with Major subject as one of her choices then the choice of Major may be upgraded as long as online admission process continues and seats remain vacant in that subject(s) if every time students shall take admission and give up-gradation option.**
- **All students will have to choose one Minor Subject as obtained in the admission portal.**
- **All admission fees will be paid online, and physical verification of admitted candidates will be done in the college, which will be notified in college website.**
- **The commencement of classes will be notified online through our college website, students who will be admitted to our college are directed to visit the college website on a regular basis for upgraded information.**
- **Reservation quotas as per government rules will be maintained for SC, ST, OBC A, OBC B, EWS (certificate must be issued in the current financial year) and PWD candidates. Original copies of all certificates will have to be produced at the time of verification in the college.**

Note: Marks of Compulsory Environmental Studies / Environmental Education will not be taken in any calculation for the Merit List.

- **Any false information whatsoever will lead to the immediate cancellation of candidature, even if the student has been admitted with full fees. No fees will be refunded in that case.**
- **1st Year Candidates who failed to fill up examination forms for Sem-1 and Sem-2 Examinations in 2025-26, will have to apply afresh for admission to the 1st Year/ 1st Semester class of 2026.**
- **Only candidates who have passed HS or equivalent examination from a recognised Board/ Council will be eligible to apply for admission into 1st semester, UG Courses.**
